Environmental Grants Program



<u>About</u>

The Environmental Grant Program provides reimbursement funding to units of local government for solid waste management, air quality initiatives, energy efficiencies, smart growth, and stormwater projects, with a goal of promoting best management practices within Madison County.

Grants of up to \$15,000 are awarded to qualifying projects with the following conditions:

- Twenty percent (20%) matching funds are provided by the applicant
 In-kind funds (transportation, mileage, labor) are permitted
- Project must be paid for prior to requesting reimbursement
- Local government provides a resolution of support
- Letters of support are strongly encouraged, but not required
- Equipment purchases require up to three (3) bids

Ineligible projects include:

• Recreation equipment, transportation, mileage, labor, education, disposal fees, tractors and/or wheeled vehicles, generators powered by gas, diesel, or propane unless upgrading to more efficient models
